Jump Cut

EFFECT: A card is selected, signed and returned to the deck. The magician casually shows the top two cards of the deck and places these two random cards back to back and 'clips' them together with a paperclip and lays them on the table out in the open.

The magician then goes into the deck and finds the selected card. The magician openly rips the card into four pieces and places these pieces together with a second paperclip. With the spectator's card clearly showing, the magician waves his hand over the clipped pieces and they are gone!

The spectator is instructed to pick up the tabled packet – and between the two clipped cards is the THIRD spectator's card.

METHOD: You need two paperclips, a sharple marker and a duplicate of any card, and something to vanish a card.

PRESENTATION: Force one of the duplicates on your spectator and have him sign it. Take that card back and control it – second to the top.

Double lift the top two cards and show the indifferent – holding the two cards as one. Place the second card 9clearly showing that neither card is the selection) and place them back to back in one hand. Place a paperclip on the (3) cards and flash both sides again and lay them on the table.

Go through the deck and find the duplicate card – remove it with most of your hand covering the face (to hide the signature that is not there) turn it to face you and proceed to rip it into fourths. Place one of the "pips" on the face so the spectator can see the identity of the card. Clip all four pieces with the second paperclip.

THE VANISH: The vanish is up to you – with the paperclip on there – you could vanish everything with one clean pass of the raven. You can vanish it in an egg bag, with a French drop, with a "Who is right, who is wrong" utility, with a himber wallet – the choice is yours.

Once the card is gone – have the spectator open up the tabled packet and reveal the signed card!
